



## Fuel Tank Packing Instructions – Kit EAAFT-CUSTOM

- 1 Ensure residual fuel is removed to the maximum extent possible. Use absorbent material (**provided**) to wipe down tank after it's been emptied.
- 2 Close and secure all tank openings (e.g., using tape, caps etc.). Place fuel tank (maximum 1) and absorbent material (**provided**) in the 4-mil polyethylene bag (**provided**) and seal the bag using zip tie (**provided**). Place fuel tank already inside the 4-mil polyethylene bag inside the extra poly bag (**provided**) and seal with the extra zip tie (**provided**).
- 3 Place the sealed plastic bag using zip tie(**provided**) in the fiberboard box (**provided** – this maybe dropped shipped to you).
- 4 Use the INSTAPAK (**provided**). Add additional cushioning material if needed. Fuel tank should not rattle inside the package when closed.
- 5 Close box with fiber tape (**provided**). Use additional packing tape to secure box. Apply the Class 9 UN3363 DANGEROUS GOODS IN APPARATUS label (**provided**) on the box in a diamond position.
- 6 Prepare Dangerous Goods declaration using UN3363 DANGEROUS GOODS IN APPARATUS Class 9 basic description.
- 7 Be sure to include a copy of ERG 128 (**provided**) on package using the packing slip envelope (**provided**).

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### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

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#### TOYOTA REMINDER WHEN SHIPPING FUELS TANKS:

- 1) Tape the paperwork to the side of the box
- 2) Include a second in the box, not attached to anything
